THE 2010 TEACHER SEMINARS FELLOWSHIPS

in cooperation with Oxbridge Academic Programs*

Every year, we offer a number of full and partial fellowships to outstanding teachers, librarians, and school leaders, as well as counselors and administrators. Full fellowships cover all tuition and seminar fees, plenary speakers and seminar activities, as well as accommodation and two meals daily. Fellowships do not cover airfare, domestic travel inside England or France, lunch daily, or personal expenses.

We offer *two* kinds of Fellowship:

OUTSTANDING TEACHER FELLOWSHIPS

Teachers must be nominated by a former student of one of our programs. Only one teacher may be nominated per alum.

CAREER TEACHER FELLOWSHIPS

Teachers must be nominated by their Principal or Head of School. Three years of professional teaching experience is required. Only one nominee is allowed per school.

Applicants may apply for only *one* kind of Fellowship. To qualify, please include the student's or Principal or Head of School's letter of nomination with your application, in a sealed envelope. Please also state at the top of your application form that you are applying for an Outstanding Teacher Fellowship *or* a Career Teaching Fellowship. Fellowship applicants should use a regular application form from a brochure to apply.

**Completed applications must be submitted no later than April 1, 2010.
Notification of the fellowship recipients will be made before April 15, 2010.**
